Shahdag - Quba - Khinalig

1st route



Khinalig is an island of ancient culture in the Caucasian mountains, remained isolated for centuries. Its rugged mountains and perilous cliffs shielded the village from the outside world. As a result, the inhabitants preserved a unique, unclassified language to this day.

Quba serves as a gateway leading to the awe-inspiring Caucasus Mountains, presenting a picturesque destination for those passionate about eco-tourism and seeking outdoor tranquility. The ancient mountain villages, inhabited by diverse ethnic communities, offer an excellent setting for hiking adventures and immersive ecotourism experiences.

Shahdag - Giriz

Giriz is a settlement renowned for having the most extensive snow cover in Azerbaijan. Nestled within the Shahdag region, it holds the distinction of being the most challenging village to reach. Like its neighboring counterparts, Giriz features a distinct architectural style with houses arranged in a stepped and clustered manner, complemented by cozy courtyards — a characteristic hallmark of high-altitude villages.

3rd route





Galakhudat village is situated at an altitude of 2 270 meters above sea level, making it the highest mountain village in the Quba region and the third highest in our country. It belongs to the Khinalig community and is connected to it via an 8 km mountain trail. The cliffs in Galakhudat village are an ideal place for mountaineering enthusiasts to learn and practice their skills.

Shahdag - Laza - Suvar Waterfall

4th route





Laza village is nestled at the base of Shah-Jeylak mountain, standing tall at an impressive altitude of 1 660 meters above sea level. The village is surrounded by breathtaking scenery, with numerous cascading waterfalls that flow gracefully from the rocks. The villagers lead a simple mountain life, and their population, consisting of only 170 individuals, predominantly speaks the native Lezgi language.

Suvar Waterfall - the breathtaking end point of a geographical journey. This hidden gem is a haven for adventure seekers and intrepid climbers, offering an unmissable experience that can only be savored on foot or by horseback.

6th route



7th route



However, one unique structure still stands to this day in Anykh - a notable mosque that is renowned throughout Azerbaijan.

Kuzun. Discover Kuzun, a charming village nestled in Azerbaijan's Gusar region, roughly 35 kilometers from the city of Gusar. Located just a stone's throw away from Mount is the starting point Shahdag, Kuzun mountaineering route up to Mount Bazarduzu. At 4 466 meters, Bazarduzu is Azerbaijan's highest mountain peak. The trek consists mostly of descents, with well-defined trails marked throughout. While the route is of moderate difficulty, suitable attire for mountain hiking recommended.
